Troop 603 is planning to participate in teaching/learning downhill skiing and complete the active portion of the Snow Sports merit badge. This is a family outing so the entire troop and their family members are invited to come.

Time and place of departure: Sunday, 2/7/16 at approximately **12:30 pm** from SUMC. We will depart as soon as possible after the Scout Sunday service is complete (which you should also attend!). Recommend eating before you come. Our lift tickets are valid from 2 PM until 7 PM.

Time and place of return: Sunday, 2/7/16 approximately 8:00 pm to SUMC

What to bring: Travel, lift fees, a lesson and equipment rentals are included in fee. Appropriate items needed for a skiing are warm clothes including snowpants, winter coat, hat, gloves, boots. You may bring skis or winter gear if you have it. Bring money for food at the ski lodge if desired. The Dragons patrol will provide a snack.

Cost: \$40 per person includes lift ticket, rentals, a lesson, helmet rental, snack and transportation. **The BSA national Guide to Safe Scouting requires all participants to wear a helmet at all times.** If you have your own helmet, the fee is reduced to \$30. If you plan to ski again in the future, keep in mind that you can purchase a new helmet for ~\$40 at a sporting goods store or an inexpensive used one elsewhere.
